



2021 Weston Warriors COVID-19 Exposure and Positive Cases Protocol

(Adapted from the Broward County Public School Guidelines)

Exposure to COVID-19 (exposed is defined as cumulative exposure for at least 15 minutes, within 6 feet)

Vaccinated Individuals

- I. Vaccinated Weston Warriors Participants (coaches, volunteers and Players) with an exposure to a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 are not required to quarantine if the meet the following criteria:
 - At least two (2) weeks have passed since receiving the second dose in a 2-dose series or at least two (2) weeks since receiving dosage of a single-dose vaccine AND
 - Have remained asymptomatic since their COVID-19 exposure
 - Participants who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 90 days and recovered.
- II. Vaccinated Weston Warriors Participants who do NOT meet the above criteria should follow the quarantine guidance below after exposure to the confirmed case.
- III. Participants should be advised to continue monitoring for COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days. If any symptoms develop, they should immediately self-isolate and not come to practice or games and be tested.

Unvaccinated Individuals

- I. For individuals who are not vaccinated or who have not fully vaccinated, based on CDC public health recommendations, Weston Warriors participants with an exposure to a confirmed case of COVID-19 should quarantine:
 - Return to practice or games after day 4 from last day of exposure (Day 5 or later) after receiving a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test
 - Return to practice or games after day 7 from last day of exposure (Day 8 or later) without testing if asymptomatic.
 - Participants who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 90 days and recovered do not need to quarantine.
- II. Participants should be advised to continue monitoring for COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days. If any symptoms develop, they should immediately self-isolate and not come to practice or games and be tested.

Positive for COVID-19

- I. Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 and have symptoms may return after the following criteria have been met:
 - The student receives a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and is asymptomatic, **or**
 - At least 10 days have passed since symptoms began or date of initial test AND
 - At least 24 hours have passed with no fever without the use of fever- reducing medications AND
 - Other symptoms have improved.
- II. Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 and have no symptoms, may return after the following criteria are met:
 - The student receives a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and is asymptomatic, **or**
 - At least 10 days have passed since the date of the positive test result.
